SB 9: End of Life Options for Terminally III Patients Act

SB 9 will allow a mentally capable, terminally ill adult with a prognosis of six months or less the option to obtain a prescription medication they may decide to take so they can die peacefully and end their suffering.

HB 3494: Protect Health Data Privacy Act

HB 3494 aims to safeguard private health care information by assuring that individuals have more control over their data before it is collected, stored, shared or sold to others.

HB 1628: Improved Data Collection in Civil Asset Forfeiture Cases Act

Civil asset forfeiture laws allow law enforcement to permanently take property or money from someone, even if that person is never arrested or convicted of a crime. HB 1628 improves the substance and process of collecting and reporting data about civil asset forfeiture cases.

HB 1077: Public Expression Protection Act

Reforms and updates Illinois' 20 year old SLAPP law to ensure that all First Amendment rights—freedom of speech, freedom of the press, the right to assemble or petition, and the right of association—are protected in Illinois without the threat of being punished by expensive litigation.
