**DECLARATION OF POLICE TECHNICIAN DRAGAN NIKIN**

1. My name is Dragan Nikin. I make this Declaration based on personal knowledge and to the best of my recollection.
2. I have been employed by the Chicago Police Department (“CPD”) since October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2000. My current rank is Police Technician. I am currently assigned to the Electronic and Technical Support Unit (“ETSU”) of the Gang Investigation Division. I have served in this capacity and title since April 2015. Prior to that date I worked in the Unit as a trainee.
3. I am generally familiar with the CPD’s “cell site simulator” system which is held and deployed by the Unit.
4. In late 2014, just before the Christmas holidays, I and fellow Police Technician trainee, Adam Aleszczyk, at the direction of then head of the Unit, Sgt. Jack Costa, packed the main hardware components of the CPD’s StingRay cell site simulator system into several boxes and took them to Federal Express for shipment to the manufacturer, the Harris Corporation in Melbourne, FL.
